UPCOMING DATES AND TIMELINES

50 Percent Spending Deadline

Friday October 1st, 2021 at 5:00 PM

Must request and be approved for reimbursement of at least 50 percent of your total ESG-CV grant

- Grantees awarded for first time in September are exempt
- Amounts from Disease Mitigation Budget Modifications are exempt

Discards will count as missing the deadline

Consequences for missing the deadline

- Complete CV-217 Spending Plan
- Required to submit approvable requests monthly
- Recapture of partial/full amount of grant

Switch to Updated CV-212

Before

Can use old or
new version
of CV-212

Deadline

Friday,
October 1st

After

Can only use
new version
of CV-212

Expected Turnaround*

Applications

- 1-3 weeks from submission

Executing Grant Agreements

- 1-2 weeks from submission



Being Able to Request Reimbursement

- 2-5 weeks from application submission

Executing Amendments and Modifications

- 1-2 weeks from request submission

Payment Requests Reviewed

- 1-2 weeks from request submission

Payment Request Marked Complete

- Within 1-2 weeks following monthly deadline

Direct Deposit of Reimbursement

- 4-6 weeks from monthly deadlines

Modification Limits

\$250,000 for Non-entitlement CoCs per disbursement

\$200,000 for Entitlement CoCs per disbursement

- Kansas City
- St. Louis City
- St. Louis County

No more than 10 percent of total award can be Administration

Prioritized Expenses

Homelessness Prevention

- More funding and less restrictions with SAFHR
- Using ESG-CV funds

Priority

- Case management
- Newly eligible essential services

Not the Priority

- Rental assistance
- Financial assistance

Current funds **are not** restricted

New applications and modifications **may be** restricted

Rapid rehousing is still a priority (**not restricted**)

Rental and Financial Assistance with Subsidized Housing

Needing more expense lines for CV-212

Billing for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Billing for gasoline vs mileage

When to specify the address for a shelter/office building in the detail description

Multiple submissions in a month
