**Emergency Solutions Grant Program
Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA)**

NOFA Date: September 23, 2013

Purpose:

The Missouri Housing Development Commission (MHDC), in collaboration with the Missouri Department of Social Services hereby notifies interested organizations of the availability of funds to provide emergency housing assistance to very low-income Missourians. These funds are provided through a federal grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Emergency Solutions Grant Program. The funds will be allocated in a competitive process in accordance with the Allocation Plan (ESG-100). The allocation of 2013 funds available is as indicated below:

- **\$1,973,047.05 from the Missouri Housing Development Commission**

Deadline:

Applications for funding will be accepted by MHDC in the Kansas City office until **4:30 p.m. CDT on November 22, 2013**. All applications received after the deadline will be rejected and returned to the sender. Decisions regarding funding of proposals are scheduled to be made by the commission in January 2014.

Requirements:

- Applicants must be a City/County, non-profit or partnership entity formed pursuant to applicable Missouri law, must be an entity in good standing with the state of Missouri and provide housing or housing services. Cities/Counties will have the first right of refusal before non-profits may apply directly. The list of Cities/Counties applying will be included in the application guidance (ESG-102). **Emergency Solutions Grant monies will not be awarded to individuals.**
- All proposals must be submitted on the current year's application form that is posted on the MHDC website (www.mhdc.com) and in compliance with the 2013 Application Guidance (ESG-102) also posted on the MHDC website.
- Entitlement areas receiving their own ESG allocation are eligible to apply for \$50,000; Cities/Counties are eligible to apply for up to \$50,000 per sub-grantee totaling \$150,000 and direct non-profits are eligible to apply for \$50,000 per grant. Non-profits that serve multiple counties may apply for up to \$50,000 per county up to \$100,000.
