



MO Residents - Housing Disaster Relief Intake Steps

Are you a Missouri resident impacted by a natural disaster?

You might be eligible for housing assistance!

Step 1: Find a Funded Agency

Funded partners are available in your community to help you. Find contact info and eligible counties at <https://mhdc.com/programs/community-programs/missouri-housing-trust-fund-disaster-relief-mhtf-dr/>.

Step 2: Prepare your Documents

Funded partners will ask for documents during intake. Please prepare the following:

For Rental, Mortgage, or Utility Assistance -

- Identification for Household Members 18+
- Proof of Household Income for Most Recent 30 days
- Proof of Residency
 - Examples: Lease or Deed, current utility bill or recent mail with address, written statement if homeless
- Proof of Need
 - Examples: Past due bills, copy of judgement or letter from landlord, photos or written statements of storm damage to residence

For Home Repairs -

- Identification for Household Members 18+
- Proof of Household Income for Most Recent 30 days
- Proof of Home Ownership
 - Example: Deed
- Proof of Damage to Property

Note: If your household is missing any of the documents listed above, a funded partner can assist.

Step 3: Complete Intake

- A funded partner will help determine if you are eligible for the MHTF-DR program. They will also help you complete required paperwork.
- *Note: The intake process will vary from agency to agency. Please be mindful that most partners will have waitlists to receive services.*
