Step 2: Application Submission

- Submit your organization's proposal through the [MHDC Grant Interface](#) portal for consideration.
 - If there are corrections or additional information necessary to make an application decision, MHDC staff will reach out.

Step 3: Funding Decision

- Organizations will receive email communication when a funding decision is made. Decisions are also publicly posted on the MHDC website.
- Following a funding decision, your organization will receive grant agreement documents to sign and return.
