A. Severe Cost Burden by County

MHDC has identified severely cost burdened (SCB) households as a strategic priority for affordable housing development, as described in the Five-Year Strategic Plan for Affordable Housing for the State of Missouri (originally published in 2020, updated annually). Households are considered severely cost burdened if more than 50% of gross monthly income is spent on housing-related expenses.

See the **Severe Cost Burden Among Renters by County** tables (pp. 4-5) for a list of qualifying counties.

B. Area Median Income

Area Median Incomes (AMI) are calculated by HUD for each county and each HUD Fair Market Rent Area (FMR) annually. See the **Area Median Income by County** (p. 6) and **Area Median Income by HUD Metropolitan Fair Market Rent/Income Limits Area (HMFA)** (p. 7) for current AMI data. The AMI data currently available are the FY2025 Income Limits.

NOTE: The FY2026 Income Limits are expected to be released by HUD in May 2026, and this data package will be updated to include the current data set.

C. Rural Underserved Counties

Using local population, demographic, and housing data for each Missouri county, MHDC has identified rural counties across the state that are considered underserved. For a list and map of counties that qualify as rural underserved counties, see the **Rural Underserved Counties** table (p. 8).

D. Workforce Housing Priority

Developments in counties with a median income less than the 2025 statewide median income (as established and published by HUD) are eligible for a basis increase, provided that 15% to 25% of the total units in the development are set-aside for households earning between 60% and 80% (workforce units) of the area median income. See **Workforce Housing Priority Eligible Counties** (pp. 9-11).

NOTE: The currently available Median Family Income Estimates and Income Limits is the FY2025 data. For purposes of the 2027 QAP, will utilize FY2025 to determine the Workforce Housing Priority Eligible Counties.

E. Opportunity Areas

MHDC encourages affordable housing developments in opportunity areas by targeting communities that meet the following criteria:

- Access to high-performing school systems,
- Access to transportation,
- Access to employment, and
- Located in a census tract with a 15% or lower poverty rate.

Opportunity Areas – Poverty Rate by Census Tract (pp. 12-28) lists all census tracts in Missouri, with highlighted census tracts being those with a poverty rate lesser than or equal to 15%.




